I am writing to object to the application to change the Points of Diversion of water as outlined in the above referenced filings as published in the Deseret News on March 6, 1997.

Accordingly, I request a Hearing of the above matters and would like to attend and testify.

Both the Big and Little Cottonwood Canyons are prime watershed and the location for public outdoor recreation. The development of 5019 domestic facilities in Little Cottonwood and 59 domestic facilities in Big Cottonwood Canyons is contradictory to the interests of the public. Furthermore, the proposed use of water describes the usage by Resorts including hotels and restaurants which would be totally in conflict with the usage in Little Cottonwood Canyon. I believe the proposed development is in contradiction to the County's and City's plans for the usage of the canyons.
