

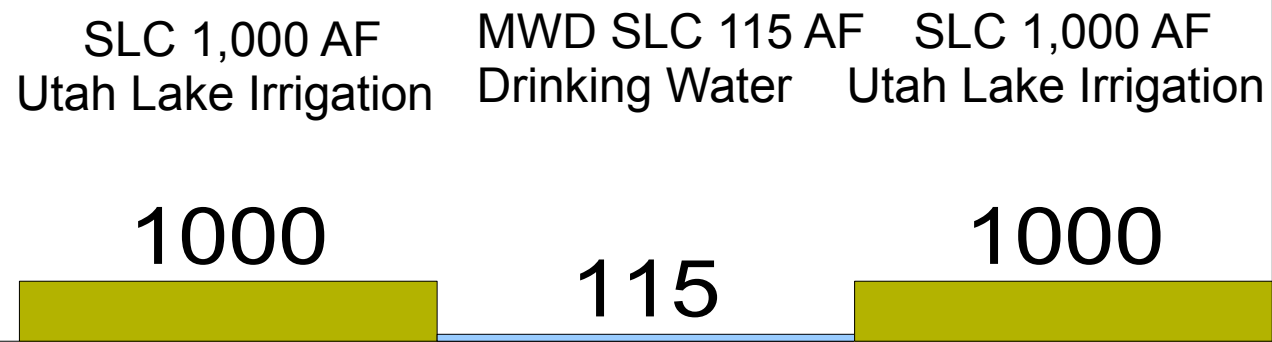
Salt Lake City traded MWD Salt Lake City 23,684 acre-feet of Utah Lake Irrigation Water for 2,772 AF of Drinking Water

Salt Lake City traded water with itself at a ratio of 1,000 acre-feet of Utah Lake Irrigation Water for 115 acre-feet of Drinking water.

Big Ditch's 35.5% Big Cottonwood water right reduced to 28.5%--approx. 14,500 avg. yield by 1914 decree.

Who would trade a water claim to 19,000 Acre-feet of drinking water for approx. 10,600\* Acre-feet of Utah Lake Irrigation Water contract which would diminish to less than 1,000 acre-feet?

SLC sued claiming it traded a 35.5% flow w/35 cfs max. contract that diminished to 1,000 AF of Utah Lake water for Big Ditch's 35.5% claim on Big Cottonwood Creek later reduced in 1914 to about 14,500 acre-feet--figures are based on decree & average SLC flow records.
