This letter is in response to your request for records dated March 5, 2008.

Request 1: The Government Records Access Management Act (GRAMA) requires that the requestor identify documents with reasonable particularity, and does not require the governmental entity to create a document or respond to requests for information that do not seek specific documents. The requestor has failed to identify a document with reasonable particularity or has requested a document that does not exist. ←

Request 2: GRAMA requires that the requestor identify documents with reasonable particularity, and does not require the governmental entity to create a document or respond to requests for information that do not seek specific documents. Request 3: Attached please find copies of the July 12, 1971 and August 16, 1982 minutes from the Board of Directors meetings. The July 12, 1971 minutes reflect the sale of Sims Well to Salt Lake City. The August 16, 1982 minutes reflect the transfer of the District's Little Cottonwood Well to Salt Lake City Corporation.


Request 4: Attached please find a copy of Resolution 1633, Interlocal agreement related to Capital Improvement and New Water Supplies, Interlocal agreement related to the acquisition of the Ontario Drain Tunnel Water Rights, and the Interlocal Agreement related to the Acquisition of New Water Sources (ULS Petition). For your information these documents were provided to you on March 9, 2007 in response to your GRAMA request dated February 15, 2007.

Request 5: GRAMA requires that the requestor identify documents with reasonable particularity, and does not require the governmental entity to create a document or respond to requests for information that do not seek specific documents. The requestor has failed to identify a document with reasonable particularity or has requested a document that does not exist.

We currently bill \$.25 per copy, and \$25/hour for research fees. For this request there were a total of 69 copies made with 2 hours of research time. The total bill comes to \$67.25.

In accordance with Public Record Access Policies enacted by MWD SLS, I am seeking to physically review and copy the following public MWD SLS record(s) specifically described:

1. A copy of the approved change application authorizing the water lease dated May 6, 1998 between MWD Salt Lake City and Utah County for the diversion and use of MWD SLC's "right to the use a part of the water supply held in storage in Deer Creek and rights in the Provo River" in Canyon View Park.
2. A copy of the current controlling conjunctive water management agreement between Sandy City, MWD SLS, Jordan Valley Water Conservation District, and Salt Lake City.
3. A copy of the documents conveying "good and valuable consideration" to the Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake City from Salt Lake City under that certain "Assignment of Application" between MWD Salt Lake City and Salt Lake City dated July 22, 1971 assigning 6 cfs of water (A25558-c) to Salt Lake City, and that certain "Assignment of Application" between MWD Salt Lake City and Salt Lake City dated August 17, 1982 assigning 6 cfs of water (A25558-b) and 4 cfs of water (A25558-d) to Salt Lake City.
4. A copy of the current controlling agreement(s) interlocal or otherwise between Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake City & Sandy and Salt Lake City, and Sandy City granting and defining their respective rights to purchase water from Metropolitan Water District of Salt Lake & Sandy together with documentation of the official nomenclature of these rights in relation to each other as to priority, first right of refusal, senior right to purchase etc., and future member city(s) of MWD SLS.
5. A copy of documentation, notes, memos, showing the type of use, location of use, and duration of use of MWD SLS's 192 shares of Big Ditch Irrigation Company.
