We have received your request dated August 28, 2007 and offer you the following:

*"1. The gross profit figures and net profit figures for FY 2005, FY 2006 for water sold outside Salt Lake City limits in Salt Lake County."*

Please note that Salt Lake City Public Utilities is a not for profit organization and has no record as described above. We have forwarded to you a copy of our financial statement for 2006. Please see attached record

*"2-The gross amount of money billed, the amount of water underlying the gross billing figure together FY 2006 from the sale of "surplus" water outside the Salt Lake City limits in Salt Lake County."*

*"3-The title, job descriptions, pay grades, and the number of positions respectively that make up the 302 positions in the water utility."*

*"4- The title, job descriptions, pay grades, and the number of positions respectively that make up the 92 positions in the sewer utility and storm drain utility."*

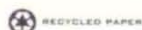

*"6-The copy of SLC water inventory or records(s) which show the water rights of any nature decree, diligence, appropriate, etc., water shares, water contracts, the rights to purchase/lease or otherwise receive any water directly or indirectly with source identified, including the amount of water contractually available to SLC from MWDSL's 61,700 acre-feet of Deer Creek, 28,600 acre-feet of CUP water, 3,100 average delivery of Dell, and MWDSL water shares, and water from all sources within 10,000 acre-feet.*

Given the extent of this records request, the most efficient way to reply is to allow you to personally inspect files which may contain the records you are seeking. These files and data will be available at the offices of the Salt Lake City Department of Public Utilities, 1530 South West Temple, from the hours of 9:00 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Thursday, by appointment only. Also, given other staff responsibilities, no more than 2 hours may be scheduled per week.


Pursuant to State law and City Ordinance, we are permitted to impose certain charges in connection with the request. For example, we may charge you for simple photocopying at 10 cents per 8 x 10 page, and certain staff time involved in complying with this request at \$10 per hour. If actual charges exceed the amount of money held on deposit for the previous request, we will require an additional deposit before further records are provided. If actual charges are less than the amount of the deposit, we will refund any difference to you.

Please let us know when you would like access to review the records so we can make the appropriate accommodations. You may contact Karryn Greenleaf at 483-6769 to make arrangements.

*"7. The gross amount of debt currently carried Salt Lake City's water utility, sewer utility, and storm drain utility. Please include relative indirect debt carried by SLC subsidiaries MWDSL, PRWUA, etc."*
