

Outsiders have taken over Alta.

The chronic litigation and contention costs of hiding the town's public records, and denying water to recorded lot owners are caused by non-Alta residents employed and/or elected in Alta.

Good people who own land in Alta, and pay taxes to Alta like former Olympian Marvin Melville have been maligned and denied water for his recorded Alta lot. A doctor/Alta land owner struggled to get public records for 5 years, but the outsiders claimed "Home Land Security" prevented that.

How can Alta residents/land owners be treated fairly where the Mayor is not a real Alta resident, Council members are not real Alta residents, the Town Clerk is a non-Alta resident, the Assistant Town Clerk is a non-Alta Resident, the Town Marshal and Deputies are non-Alta residents, the town attorney is a non-Alta resident, and a Variance Board member is a non-Alta resident?

A real Alta resident Mayor would not appoint 7 of 7 Alta Planning Commission seats to non-Alta residents (outsiders) nor let the Town Clerk, or Town Marshal, or Variance Board members be non-Alta residents.

What gives Salt Lake City the right to use its hoarded water to take over the Town of Alta?

The outsider town attorney writes an opinion supporting the outsider town clerk approving candidacy of outsiders to elected Alta positions.

The town clerk could just as easily deny the outsiders; however, the town clerk herself is a non-Alta resident (an outsider).

Alta Planning Commission meetings are not held in Alta, but at expensive restaurants like Market Street Grill and Bambara in Cottonwood Heights, and Salt Lake City where non-Alta residents (outsiders) dine on Alta's Credit Card and decide what Alta residents can and cannot do with their land. This is corruption plain and simple.

Why doesn't Mayor Ralph Becker appoint outsiders (non-Salt Lake City residents) to Salt Lake City's Planning Commission? If he did, he would be booted from office by the insiders.

Why doesn't Salt Lake City's Clerk allow non-Salt Lake City residents to run for elected offices? If he did, he would be booted from office by the insiders.

Snowbird has enough water for 2,500+ houses plus 80 million gallons for snowmaking plus 10 million gallons more with no limit for more snowmaking. Snowbird bears no water political costs, has no \$500,000 in legal fees, is not bossed about by Salt Lake City. Why? Both Alta and Snowbird are in the same "fragile," "sensitive," and "delicate" watershed. The pioneers who wrote Utah's constitution were hard rock mining, logging, building roads, and rail roads, and buildings in Big and Little Cottonwood Canyon watershed while drinking its creek water **without a treatment plant**. The Pioneers never intended that their constitution would be used to chain down Utah's canyons for

Why must Salt Lake City mis-use “watershed” to lay jurisdictional claim to an extra 110 square miles outside Salt Lake City boundaries in addition to the 90 square miles it already controls in their town?

Do we want Provo City controlling the entire Heber Valley? Do we want St. George controlling 5,000 square miles in 7 counties which are the watershed for the Green River and Colorado River?

Water from Weber County, Summit County, Wasatch County, and Duchesne County flows to the Salt Lake Valley where Salt Lake City residents drink it. Is Salt Lake City going to control all those watersheds, too?

Alta is not a safe town because it is at the end of an 8 mile cul-de-sac. On this public safety issue alone, Big and Little Cottonwood Canyons should be connected. It is not safe to have an 8 mile cul-de-sac canyon with such traffic loads in Salt Lake County.

The easements were purchased. The plans were made, but Salt Lake City stopped this safety connector. Why? When good people perish, due to this man made hazard, is that when good people will act? Why is the guard rail installed after the accident?
